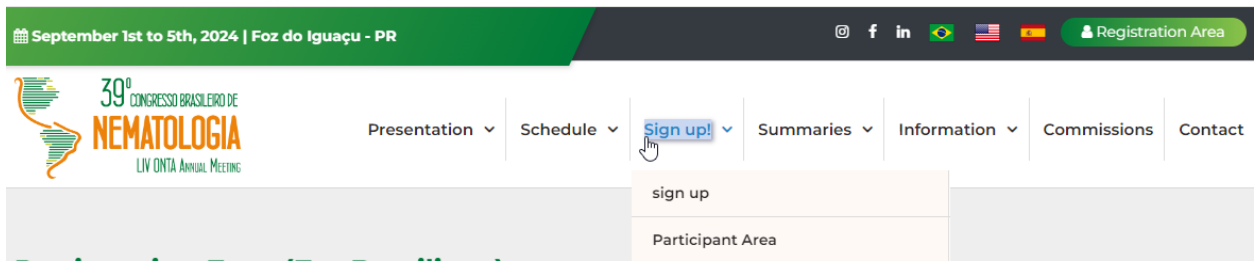

How to make your registration at the 39th CBN /LIV ONTA Joint meeting

1. At the meeting website click on 'SIGN UP'
2. New register (= New registration)
3. ENTER your email.
4. Click on CONTINUE
5. Complete all information (Fill out the Form)
6. And finalize registration – further information.
7. Click on "I've read and agree with Privacy Policy"
8. Click on Finish Registration
9. CLICK on Payments
10. You will be direct to the **PayPal page. You must make the payment using your PayPal account, if you don't have one already, please create one account, then proceed to make your payment or continue with email only as guest to complete transaction.**

Note: R = Real, Brazilian currency. If you choose Regular Member of ONTA, you will see registration fee stated at a rate of **US \$300**. Please see the Table below – the registration fee was calculated at the currency rate: US\$1.00 = R\$6.00 Brazilian Real. In summary, the registration for members of ONTA really is \$R1,800 (until July 12 - US\$300 x 6 = R\$1,800) and \$R 2,400 (after July 12 - US\$400 x 6 = R\$2,400). But the final charge in your credit card is not US\$300 because of the exchange rate at the day you are making your registration since the rate fluctuate daily, therefore the charge can be less or more than US\$300. Additionally, PayPal might add a processing fee. Please see an example below.

May 17, 2024: Deadline for abstract submissions - two abstracts (maximum) per delegate regardless if it is poster, short oral presentation or a combination of both.

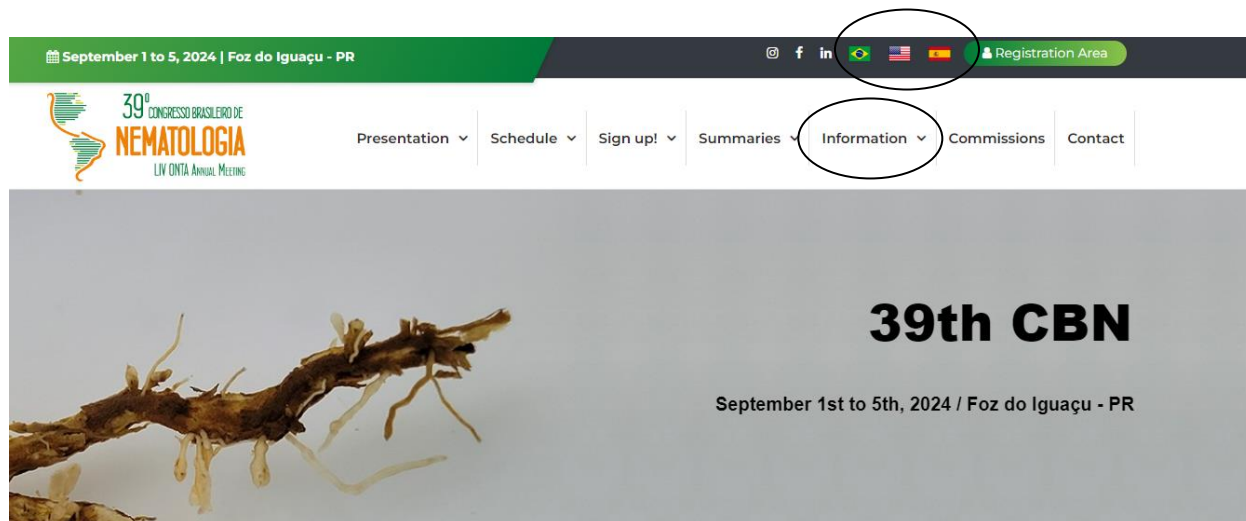

Where you see the flags of the countries choose language of choice (Portuguese, English, or Spanish). At the meeting website, click on Information, in the dropdown menu you have the list of **four** Hotels provided for our stay. The Grand Carimã Resort, is where the meeting will be held, whereas the other ones are located nearby the meeting venue. Please notice that you are responsible to make your own reservation at the hotel of your choice to stay during the meeting. However, if you want to stay at the Grand Carima Resort, the meeting venue and get a discount, please contact the hotel directly.

@ - Visa Exemption, for a period not exceeding ninety (90) days, for officials not accredited in Brazil. For accredited officials, visa exemption for the period of their mission. Dependent children up to 16 years old are visa exempt. Dependent children more than 16 years old, visa for a period not exceeding 2 years.
* - Maximum stay of 90 days every 180 days
1. Visa required.
2. Visa Exemption, for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days
3. Visa Exemption, for a period not exceeding sixty (60) days.
4. Visa Exemption, for a period not exceeding ninety (90) days.
5. Visa Exemption, for a period not exceeding ninety (90) days, for officials not accredited in Brazil. For accredited officials, Visa for the period of the mission.
6. Visa Exemption, for a period not exceeding ninety (90) days, for officials not accredited in Brazil. For accredited officials, Visa Exemption to enter into Brazilian territory. The accredited officials must request to the Ministry of External Relations of Brazil for a Visa for the period of their mission no later than thirty (30) days after their first entry in Brazilian territory.
7. Visa Exemption, for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days, for officials not accredited in Brazil. For accredited officials, Visa Exemption for the period of their mission.
8. Visa Exemption, for a period not exceeding ninety (90) days, for officials not accredited in Brazil. For accredited officials, Visa Exemption for the period of their mission.
9. Visa Exemption, for a period not exceeding one hundred and eighty (180) days, for officials not accredited in Brazil. For accredited officials, Visa Exemption for the period of their mission.
10. Visa Exemption, for a period not exceeding fourteen (14) days, for officials not accredited in Brazil. For accredited officials, Visa Exemption for the period of their mission.
11. Visa exemption, for an indefinite period of time, for accredited and non-accredited officials.
12. Brazil does not maintain diplomatic relations. Visas issued for a period not exceeding ninety (90) days. No issuance of Diplomatic or Official Visas.
13. Brazil does not maintain diplomatic relations. Visas issued on "Laissez-Passer" for a period not exceeding ninety (90) days. No issuance of Diplomatic or Official Visas.

14. Brazil does not maintain diplomatic relations. VIVIS valid for up to five (5) years, with stays of 90 days. No issuance of Diplomatic or Official Visas.

15. Visa Exemption, for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days, for officials not accredited in Brazil. For accredited officials, Visa Exemption to enter into Brazilian territory. The accredited officials must request to the Ministry of External Relations of Brazil for a Visa for the period of their mission no later than thirty (30) days after their first entry in Brazilian territory.

16. Visa Exemption for stays of up to 14 days, extendable for a maximum period of 90 days every 12 months.

17. Visa valid for 10 years, with stays of up to 90 days, not exceeding 180 days every 12 months.
